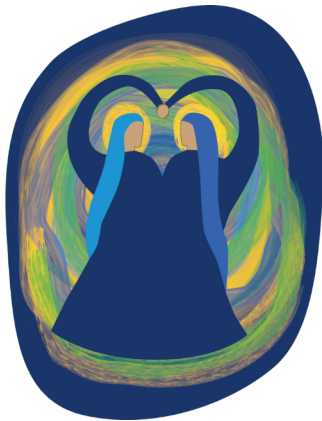

Neomi De Anda, theologian and Lay Marianist, serves as the Executive Director of the International Marian Research Institute and is an Associate Professor in Religious Studies at the University of Dayton. She teaches courses in religion, languages and

cultures, Latinx and Latin American studies, race and ethnic studies and women and gender studies. She holds a Ph.D. in Constructive Theology from Loyola University, Chicago. She also has Master's degrees in Theology (Oblate School of Theology) and Educational Leadership (St. Mary's University, San Antonio).
